

Notes of a Gathering at Animal Control
February 21, 2008

Due to a lack of a quorum, no meeting of the Animal Control Board of Directors could be held. Directors present included Stan Leach, Steve Meersman, Chief John Wright and Virgil Dueysen. Staff present included Richard Glessner and Sam DeYoung.

Chief Wright wanted to make a motion at this meeting to begin holding the meetings every other month or perhaps quarterly. Now that the Shelter is up and running, there is not as much business to require a meeting each month. Mr. Leach agreed with the recommendation. Mr. Glessner added that the statistics have balanced out now that the shelter is 2 years old. Special meetings could be called should a situation arise. It was recommended that the meetings be held near the Black & White and Golf Fundraisers to provide additional details.

This matter will be placed on the **March 20th** agenda.

For information, Mr. Glessner advised that Harris Pizza has placed fire hydrant banks in their Rock Island and Bettendorf locations. These are generating about \$100 per location per month in donations. The owner of Harris Pizza is donating 2 new 75 gallon hot water heaters and their installation. This is about a \$4,200 donation.

One groomer has left, and things seem to be working out fine with just one.
